- To help teachers understand the students different realities and better integrate them in the classroom
- To identify limiting & negative beliefs and transform them into positive and supporting ones
- To understand physical & mental health issues within the teaching profession
- To improve interpersonal relationships
- To introduce new tools & resources within the classroom to foster well-being Reduce early school leaving
- To acquire understanding of the various forms of BULLING and cyber-bulling and knowledge about impact, risk and long-term effect of victims and bullies
- To analyse bullying, aggressive behaviour (physical and verbal), creating strategies on how to deal with and eliminate them
- To develop e- learning competences about recognizing and prevention cyber-bulling
- To develop the needed knowledge and competences to prevent all forms of bulying and cyber-bulling in education and school settings
- To promote the use mediation and negotiation tools in the fight against exclusion of people with fewer opportunities
- To promote European cooperation in the field of education within the framework of the Erasmus+ program by partnership building
